




### \* <u>DEVELOPMENT OF SUPPORT</u> <u>STRUCTURES</u>

- <u>AMNIOTIC SAC/AMNION</u>- protective fluid and covering to cushion.
- <u>PLACENTA</u>- supplies nutrients from the mother to the baby. Go-Between.
- UMBILICAL CORD- tube to bring nutrients and waste to and from placenta and baby.








## **TIMELINE**

- -Trimester 3- months 7-9





## TIMELINE OF DEVELOPMENT MONTH ONE Heart, spinal cord, backbone & digestive





































## DELIVERY
